_____ **Adopt a Station:** Members plant and maintain flowers and shrubs around the Spring Lake train station.

_____ **Civic Beautification:** Our club plants the large flower containers at the North and South Pavilions.

_____ **Fall Luncheon:** In October, the club holds a luncheon; members are encouraged to actively head or serve on the various committees.

_____ **Floral Design:** Members participate in workshops on design.

_____ **Garden Tour:** Annually we host a tour that attracts visitors from the tri-state area. All members are expected to participate. Check here if you wish to head or actively serve on a committee.

_____ **Fulfill:** Members volunteer at the Fulfill facility on Route 66 in Neptune planting seeds, etc. Fulfill is the current name of the Monmouth & Ocean Counties Food Bank.

_____ **Horticulture:** Members present to the club the science, art, and care of growing various plants.

_____ **Landscaping, Holy Trinity Church:** An on-going landscaping project includes planting, weeding and watering at an 1880 Spring Lake summer church that is on the National Historic Register.

_____ **Native Plants:** A new project in coordination with the Boro at the Reclamation Center. The native plants attract butterflies and bees for pollination and provide a natural habitat for birds.

_____ **Operation Sunshine:** During the first week of May, we remember people who need a little sunshine in their lives and distribute floral arrangement to senior facilities in the area. Throughout the year, homebound club members are remembered with cards and small flower arrangements.

_____ **Perennial Gardens:** The club maintains a perennial garden at the Municipal Building.

_____ **Plant it Pink:** To promote breast cancer awareness, pink flowers are planted at the Welcome to Spring Lake sign.

_____ **Publicity:** Monthly announcements and special news articles promote the activities of the club.

_____ **Random Acts of Beauty:** The selection of a variety of front gardens of homes and businesses providing a sense of beauty.

_____ **Scholarships:** Seniors of local high schools who plan to study horticulture or environmental subjects in college are awarded scholarships based on an application.
